Secure access beyond workforce credentials, extend your access strategy to AI agents, scripts, and automated workflows. Store secrets like SSH keys, API tokens, and environment variables in encrypted vaults with fine-grained access controls. Service accounts give bots and scripts the access they need without the risk of plaintext credentials or hardcoded secrets. You get complete visibility, auditable access, and policy-driven control over every machine and non-human identity in your environment.

Protect your account with a Secret Key

1Password's security model is fundamentally different from Keeper. 1Password protects your data with an encryption key that combines your account password with a unique Secret Key. This approach ensures your data can better-resist attacks from bad actors.
